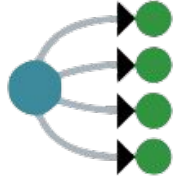
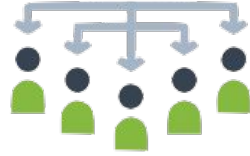


What happens to the textiles collected?



Sorting for Reuse

The collected textiles and household goods are sorted into over 500 different categories to ensure they are kept circulating in the system for beneficial use.



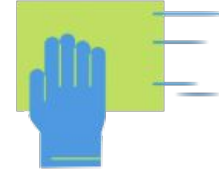
Distribution

Textiles enter the marketplace or further recycling via distributors, agents, individuals - some are connected directly and some indirectly.



Processing /Selling

Textiles are either processed or are sold to consumers - this can be online, in physical markets, in charity shops, or any method new textiles are sold.



Damaged Textiles

Damaged textiles are processed for fibre reclamation into blankets, wiper/cleaning products, PEF for energy release, upcycled into new products for reuse.
